

USS Kearsarge Reunion May 25 - 29, 2020

All tours begin and end at DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel Milwaukee Downtown 611 W Wisconsin Avenue.

All motorcoaches are deluxe 56-passenger motorcoaches with professional driver, comfortable seating, climate control, and onboard restroom. Wheelchairs and walkers may be stored in the luggage bay underneath the motorcoach. Motorcoaches are equipped with microphone and sound system for onboard tour narration. Motorcoaches arrive at the hotel to stage at least 20 minutes prior to scheduled departure time.

TASTE OF MILWAUKEE TOUR

This guided tour gives you a great overview of Milwaukee learning about the city's history as well as the current progress. We'll see the major influence the European immigrants had on the city's architecture, business, and culture earning nicknames such as "Brew City", "Machine Shop to the World" and "City of Festivals". We will have a short Memorial Service at the Milwaukee County War Memorial overlooking Lake Michigan to begin our day. The War Memorial overlooks the Milwaukee Art Museum providing a good vantage point to watch the brise soleil or "wings" open. As we travel throughout the city, we will see some of the iconic Milwaukee sites such as City Hall, Basilica of St Josaphat, the former breweries and yes, the Bronze Fonz - reminding us of Happy Days in Milwaukee. We'll also travel along the Lake Michigan shoreline seeing the beautiful waterfront views and Lake Drive mansions. We'll receive a "Milwaukee Goodie Bag" which includes tasty Milwaukee treats that define the city and the different neighborhoods. Lunch will be at Polonez, a popular southside restaurant providing family style Polish lunch. Bring your appetite for good food and fun!

HOPS & HOGS

This tour highlights the products that make Milwaukee famous. Great beer brewing history and an American Classic - Harley-Davidson Motorcycles. Our day begins at the Harley-Davidson Museum where you can see Harley-Davidson motorcycles and the culture surrounding them over the past 117 years, including the first motorcycle from 1903. Bring a camera for pictures on several of the models as well as feeling the signature rumble on the Jumpstart. We'll enjoy a German Sampler Plate lunch at Mader's German Restaurant, a favorite on Milwaukee's Old World Third Street since 1902. Milwaukee, at one time had four major breweries, making it known as the Beer and Brewing Capital of the World. This tour will take you on a trip through the city learning about the beer barons, namely Blatz, Schlitz, Pabst and Miller, and their impact on the city of Milwaukee from theaters and social halls to major league ballparks. We'll see the magnificent mansion built by Captain Frederick Pabst and visit the former Pabst Brewery, now called Best Place at the Historic Pabst Brewery, with its great history, 9:00am - Depart Hotel--- 3:30pm - Return to Hotel \$68 per person includes motorcoach transportation, tour escort, admission fees to Harley-Davidson Museum and Best Place, lunch + waitstaff gratuity.

HISTORIC CEDARBURG & MILWAUKEE SIGHTSEEING CRUISE

We'll travel north to visit Historic Cedarburg and the Cedar Creek Settlement featuring specialty gift shops, galleries and Cedar Creek Winery all within 4 blocks in the quaint historic village of Cedarburg on Cedar Creek. We'll see one of the few remaining Covered Bridges in Wisconsin and a short stop at the Wisconsin Museum of Quilts & Fiber Arts. Lunch will be included at The Cannery - St Paul Fish Market with a selection of grilled and fried fish as well as non-seafood items and all the accompaniments. Following lunch, we'll relax on a sightseeing cruise in Milwaukee. Some say the name Milwaukee derives from a Native American word meaning "Gathering Place by the Waters" and a great way to see Milwaukee is via the waterways. We'll sail through downtown and the revitalized Historic Third Ward neighborhoods on the Milwaukee River and through the Port of Milwaukee into Lake Michigan where we'll see beautiful views of the Milwaukee skyline.
